Rob Morrell convened the meeting at 11:01am (ET).

Rob Barto updated the Committee on his success in recruiting 5 new OEM representatives to this Committee. (View the committee roster from the committee webpage at www.nastf.org/committees/education.)

Morrell led a discussion of the committee's project: OEM Education Resources, which was previously defined to include independent trainer licensing and guidance to the OEM as to resource needs, search and navigation. Morrell & Warren volunteered to author a letter to OEMs for the purpose of engaging them in this project. Upon completion of the draft (on March 24, 2014) Potter will distribute it to the Committee for comment. The Committee agreed that a test of the committee's "recommendation" will be limited first to the 5 OEMs represented on the Education Committee.

Potter reported that NASTF has been invited to address the OEM Education Roundtable during ATMC in Atlanta on April 7. The committee recommended Potter include the following topics in his presentation:

- Clarify the intent of regulations and OEM guidance on educational resources
- Introduce the market-motive for sales of OEM education resources
