Morgan convened the meeting at 11:03am eastern and confirmed attendance.

Bartanen provided the committee with an update of the I-CAR Repairability Technical Support website, particularly the OEM information which can be viewed at <http://rts.i-car.com/oem-information.html>. The committee welcomed this effort by I-CAR but expressed concern that it would continue to be offered as an open-access to the industry and not become an exclusive I-CAR membership product. Bartanen asked the committee's assistance in recruiting Hyundai's participation in this project.

The Committee was informed by Potter that the NASTF Spring 2015 General Meeting will be held on Thursday, March 19, 2015 in advance of and in cooperation with AASP-NJ at their Northeast2015 event in Secaucus, NJ (NY City metro). Given the collision focus of this event, the Committee suggested a featured session of the NASTF meeting should address the unique needs of the collision repairer in drivability system diagnostics and its differences from common auto service. A component of this suggestion is the collision shop's lack of familiarity with diagnostic tools.
