Potter reviewed the SIRs with a demonstration of the public view at [www.nastf.org/SIRarchive](http://www.nastf.org/SIRarchive) where committee members are encouraged to monitor and comment on staff's handling of this important service. A question arose about open SIR #680 where NASTF is awaiting an update from Volvo on the troubles in the launch version of VIDA2015. NASTF will publish updates in the OEM NEWS section of a subsequent NASTF Newsletter.

Potter led a tour of the NASTF page of the OEM Scan Tool Resource Center, showing the recent addition of notes and links for OEMs not yet included in Donny Seyfer's core version of the "Center". A question was asked if NASTF had information about OEM progress towards compliance with the Mass R2R and MOU relating to diagnostics using J2534.
