Saunders convened the meeting at 11:01am (ET) and roll call was conducted.

Morrell reported work on the 3<sup>rd</sup> party Guidelines Project on-hold while planning for the Education Committee's featured session, March 2 at the NASTF Spring 2016 General Meeting.

Morrell outlined the objectives of the March 2 featured session as defined already by the planning workgroup (Morrell, Saunders, Saxonberg, Brown, Chesney) asking the committee for additional ideas. As the planning workgroup attempts to first define the title and key points of the session, guidance appears to follow these ideas:

- OEMs have a defined technician development process which is well-known among dealers. The aftermarket, while it has significant training resources, has a little-defined and not well-known process. It needs a roadmap.
- NASTF must have all education organizations involved in this discussion as NASTF's role is to coalesce "a vision for the development of great technicians" and ensure the industry will share that vision among stakeholders.

NASTF needs a contact with the SAE project committee on OEM education resources. Saxonberg will coordinate with Potter to identify the correct person.
