Douglas convened the meeting at 11:03am (ET) and S. Potter conducted roll call.

Potter reported no operational issues with the SIR, encouraging SIC members to occasionally review the [SIR Archive](#) with a watchful eye for suggestions and errors. NASTF handled 22 SIRs since the March 9 meeting including three HD truck issues. NASTF SIR contacts have been established for HD truck participants.

Seyfer updated the committee on the Scan Tool Resource Center, indicating that FCA and GM page updates were pending the OEM approval. Potter reported a possible issue with JLR and will send Seyfer the name of the individual making that claim.

In absence of Zwalina, Potter reported that committee recommendations on [nastf.org](#) reprogramming and OEM master pages were on hold pending instruction from the NASTF board following a suggested strategic planning session.

The committee discussed the joint ETC/SIC programming and diagnostic feature session to be part of the November 2, 2016 NASTF Fall 2016 General Meeting in Las Vegas. The title and promotional tag line for the event proposed by the ETC was approved: "Take the Box Outa' the Box: How to configure your J-device and get started using it." Further, the committee suggested to subdivide the 90 minute session into three elements:

- Introduction of topic (Podium presentation by Seyfer or Immekus)
- Installing the OEM's SAEJ2534 (Brian Heron, Drew Technologies)
- Uses and Limitations of the SAEJ2534 tool (Panel discussion. Panelists tba)

Additionally, the committee affirmed the ETC plan to prepare a pdf "handout" for download to accompany the session video content.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:44am after the Go2Meeting web-side prematurely terminated due to an Internet provider disruption at the organizer's office. (ET)
