Seyfer presented a summary of ASA's OEM Repair Information center, developed with support by the Alliance of Automotive Manufacturers. The OEM pages are publicly available but a related blog is intended for launch as an ASA member benefit. The Committee discussed possible duplication of effort.

Zwalina led a discussion of the SIC's NASTF Reprogramming pages encouraging a campaign for greater awareness and use. Holland volunteered to initiate an iATN discussion on the topic.

Potter asked the SIC for opinion of maintaining a combined or separate list of OEM Website URLs. With a split opinion, Potter will work with Zwalina and Hazzard to develop a solution for SIC review.
