Saunders led a discussion to redefine the “Guidelines” project. The committee agreed to rename the project to “OEM-Aftermarket Educator Resource Agreement.” Saunders and Potter summarized the content of a presentation made on this committee’s behalf by John Saia to the OEM Education Manager’s Roundtable and of a summary of comments returned. This is a living document and committee members are encouraged to submit to skippotter@nastf.org comments and suggestions on how best to present the issues, objectives and sense of this project to interested parties. The committee agreed to establish a set of measurements (example: % of shops having a student intern/job shadow during the calendar year) in order for the project to monitor progress of this effort. Morrell & Potter will discuss this idea with Trish Serratore (NATEF).
