- Residents of **Massachusetts** with concerns involving vehicle service information and tools for MY 2002 or newer light duty vehicles or MY 2013 or newer heavy duty vehicle, may contact appropriate legal counsel regarding their rights and remedies under Chapter 93K of the Massachusetts code.
- Concerns in any U.S. state involving MY 2002 and newer light duty vehicles may be directed to the Light Duty Dispute Resolution Panel (DRP) at govaffairs@autocare.org.
- Concerns in any U.S. state involving MY 2010 and newer heavy duty vehicles may be directed to the Heavy Duty Dispute Resolution Panel (DRP) at avolpe@cvsn.org.
